Application for Student Grant Implementation of Blended Mode of Learning and “Quality Education Fund e-Learning Funding Programme – Provision of Mobile Computer Devices and Internet Services Support” (2021/22 School Year)

In the 2021/22 school year, our school will implement a blended mode of learning, i.e. face-to-face classes, e-learning at home or other modes of learning. The aim is to enhance learning independent and flexibility so that students can learn effectively when face-to-face classes are suspended. We therefore recommend students should have their own personal mobile computer device. To support e-learning resources and applications adopted by our school, the specifications of the device required are listed as follows:

To alleviate the financial burden of students from low-income families under the development of blended mode of learning, our school will participate in the “Quality Education Fund e-Learning Funding Programme—Provision of Mobile Computer Devices and Internet Services Support” launched by the Education Bureau, and apply for funding to schools to purchase mobile computer devices for loan to needy students.

Our school therefore would like to know whether students need to apply for related equipment. Eligible students are those who are receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) from the Social Welfare Department, or full/half grant of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS) from the Student Finance Office; or students with limited economic means identified by schools. (If students’ families face financial difficulties but are not receiving CSSA or STAS due to special circumstances, they may provide schools with explanations or supplementary information. The EDB provides a limited amount of quota to our school for purchasing e-learning equipment for loan to needy students with genuine needs identified by school-based criteria.)

Please complete and return the required (1) reply slip and (2) supporting documents to the class teacher by **8 November 2021**. If the result of CSSA/STAS is pending, parents/ guardians may submit the reply slip first by the above date and then return the notification document from CSSA/STAS by **6 December 2021**.
