**Positive Parent Education Film Gala Presentations
“I Have Arrived” - Parent-Child Film Appreciation and Sharing Session**


To assist parents in supporting the healthy growth of their children and acquiring the knowledge and skills of taking care of their children’s mental health, the Positive Parent Education Film Gala Presentations organised by the Education Bureau (EDB) in collaboration with the Committee on Home-School Co-operation and Jockey Club “Peace and Awareness” Mindfulness Culture in Schools Initiative (funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust) was successfully conducted from November to December 2024. In view of the overwhelming enrolment and responses, EDB will organise additional four sessions of “I Have Arrived” - Parent-Child Film Appreciation and Sharing Session from February to April 2025.

Apart from film appreciation, EDB has also invited educational psychologists to share with parents on the tips of enhancing the emotional well-being of families, as well as ways to listen to their children’s voices and promote parent-child relationship during the interactive session of the Sharing Session, to guide parents to rethink the way of getting along with their children. The activity concerned is free of charge. The details of the activity is as follows:
